Application are invited from eligible candidates within the age limit of 18 to 38 years (relaxation as per Govt. rules) for filling up 1(one) post of Peon under the Establishment of SDJM(M), Bokakhat and 2(Two) posts of Night Chowkidar one each in the establishment of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Golaghat and SDJM(M), Sarupathar respectively.

- **The Candidates who have earlier applied for the post of Chowkidar under the establishment of SDJM(M), Sarupathar, as per advertisement no: "Janasanyog/196/15, dated 28/05/2015, need not to file fresh application.**
- The applicants must submit their applications in the Standard Form of application published in the Assam Gazette Part IX with self attested photocopy of caste certificate (If any) and three (3) copies of recent passport size photograph.
- The selection will be carried out in 2 phases,
  - Written test: multiple choice questions carrying maximum marks of 50. Admit cards will be issued to applying candidates to appear in the written test.
  - Personal interview: candidates, who qualify in the written test, will be called for the personal interview. A list of successful candidates will be published in the website of Golaghat District Judiciary website <http://golaghatjudiciary.gov.in/>
  - No other document/testimonials should be submitted alongwith the application form. However, candidates will have to produce the testimonials in original, in terms of his/her Age, Caste and Educational Qualification etc. during personal interview, after qualifying the written test.
- Completed applications alongwith all testimonials as mentioned above should be addressed to the "The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Golaghat, PIN 785621, Assam" and should be dropped in the "Drop Box" Labeled as "Drop Box for Applications" to be kept at the premise of Office of the undersigned within the stipulated date & time.
- **Last date of receipt of application in the "Drop Box" is 24/08/2016 upto 5 pm. Drop box will be closed after last date and time.**

- Application submitted in any other mode, except as indicated and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected without any communication to the candidate.
- **Canvassing by any means will immediately lead to rejection of candidature.**
- Candidates who are already in the Government services must submit "No Objection Certificate" from appropriate authority at the time of interview.
- Selected candidates will receive their appointment letters by post at their respective postal address as specified by them in their application form.
- Experience in the relevant field will be counted
