AGENDA NO.1

Status report on pending P.M. Report and other Medico Legal Reports. *(This issue has been taken up for discussed with reference to the resolution on Agenda No.3, in the meeting held on 04.10.2016.)*

RESOLUTION:-

The Superintendent, K.K. Civil Hospital, Golaghat who accompanied the Joint Director of Health Services, Golaghat, has apprised the committee about the current status of cases in which the reports are pending. She has furnished a list before the committee which reveals that in the month of **November** only **12 injury reports, 3 P.M. reports** and **5 reports in rape cases** are pending. The committee is further apprised that in some cases reports have been prepared and the same have not been collected by police, and whatever pendency is there, the same will be made ready for delivery very soon. The committee, having discussed the issue, resolved to request the Joint Director of Health Services, Golaghat to supervise the matter personally so that all pending reports get cleared within this year and nothing is carried forward to the next year.

AGENDA NO.2:

Disposal of seized articles in NDPS cases.

RESOLUTION:-

This agenda assumes much significance in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Union of India Vs. Mohanlal & Another, Criminal Appeal No. 652***




of 2012, where in Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed for carrying out disposal of seized Drugs and Psychotropic substances lying in the police malkhana and other places. The committee is being informed by the District Judge that though a copy of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court was furnished to the Addl. Superintendent of Police long back, yet, no visible step has been taken so far for implementation of the directions given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court. The Addl. S.P. has informed that he has already issued instructions to all the Investigating Officers and he will inquire about the same. The members resolve to request the Superintendent of Police for carrying out the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its letter and spirit by taking immediate steps.


AGENDA NO.3:


Production of vulnerable UTPs before the court through video conferencing.

RESOLUTION:-

The members present discussed the matter of production of UTPs before the different courts in the districts and the difficulties faced by Police and Jail in this regard. Having discussed the issue, the committee resolved to request the Superintendent of Police and District Jail, Golaghat to avail the facility of producing the vulnerable UTPs before the courts through the V.C., as provided in Section 167(2) (b) Cr.P.C., to overcome such difficulties.
