

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF DISTRICT REVIEW COMMITTEE FOR THE UNDER TRIAL PRISONERS IN DISTRICT JAIL, GOLAGHAT HELD ON 24.06.2015, IN THE OFFICE CHAMBER OF THE DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE, GOLAGHAT:**

*Review of cases of under trial prisoners, who have undergone detention for a period extending up to one half of the maximum period of imprisonment specified for that offence, with reference to Notification. No.HMB. 76/2002/378, dated 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2013.*


**R E S O L U T I O N :**

1. The committee has perused the list of under trial prisoners of all the courts of Golaghat District, including the courts of Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dhansiri and Bokakhat, placed before it by the Superintendent of District Jail, Golaghat, covering the period of February, March and April, 2015, and reviewed all such cases of the under trial prisoners languishing in District Jail, Golaghat. It is found that none of the UTP has undergone detention for a period extending up-to one-half of the maximum period of imprisonment specified for that offence under that law as provided in Section 436(A) of the Cr.P.C. It is also found that none of them also completed one fourth of the maximum period of imprisonment.
2. The committee also discussed about the under trial prisoners, who have been ordered to be released on bail but failed to furnish surety bonds and considered the scope of releasing them on P. R. Bond, and of the view that in less serious offences, the same may be considered and in case of the out stationed accused where the attendance could not be procured easily, the under trial prisoners may not be released on P.R. Bond. The

Superintendent of Police suggested that if a list of such under trial prisoners be furnished to him then he will issue instruction to all the I.O. to complete investigation of their cases on priority basis and to submit F/F on early date. Such a list may be furnished by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Golaghat to the S.P. for doing needful from his end. The committee is also opinion that in Sessions cases, where the offences are very serious, this exercise may not be opted for.
