RESOLUTION:-

- 1. The District Judge has pointed out about the defects in the bail objection petition filed by the concerned I.O. in the court. The Superintendent of Police has assured that he will look into the matter.
- 2. The Superintendent of Police has insisted upon fast tracking of a particular case of kidnapping of child and enlarging of accused persons on bail. In view of giving more importance upon quick disposal of five years old cases by the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court giving much importance to a particular case of the year 2015 is not possible. And since investigation of the case is already been completed the matter of bail, which was given by Hon'ble Gauhati High Court, it has been decided to abstain from any discussion about the same considering the object behind holding this meeting.
- 3. The District Judge has insisted upon the S.P. Golaghat to send the original copy of the Inquest Report along with the charge sheet in cases under section 302 IPC. The Superintendent of Police assured that he will issue necessary instruction to all the I.O to do the same.

4. The District Judge also insisted upon prompt investigation of the cases in which the accused persons have been languishing in jail beyond the statutory period for failing to furnish surety though enlarged on bail. The Superintendent has stated that he has not received any list of cases from the Chief Judicial Magistrate in view of discussion in earlier meeting and assured to look after the same as soon as he receive the list.
