

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING DATED 21.5.2021 OF THE DISTRICT LEGAL SERVICES AUTHORITY,
GOLAGHAT IN COMPLIANCE TO THE GUIDELINES OF THE HON'BLE SUPREME COURT OF INDIA.**

At 1 PM today on 21.5.2021 meeting of the District Authority, of the DLSA, Golaghat has been held under the Chairmanship of Sri V.K. Chandak, District & Sessions Judge-cum-Chairman, District Legal Services Authority, Golaghat in presence of the following members, in compliance of the Direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court given in Suo Motu Writ Petition (C), No. 1/202 and the direction of the Hon'ble Executive Chairman, ASLSA, given in the Video conference held on 18.5.2021.

Sri Taufiq Hussain, Addl. Joint Director of Health Services, Golaghat has attended as special invitee.

DISCUSSION & RESOLUTION

At the outset, Hon'ble Chairman, DLSA, Golaghat has welcomed the members present. Sri Kuri, Secretary, DLSA, Golaghat has apprised the members the content of Minute dated 12.5.2021, 16.5.21 and 17.5.21 of the High Powered Committee. Further, the content of Email dated 13.5.21 of the NALSA for submission of compliance Report in connection with the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition(C) No. 1/2020 has also been read over to the members.

Dr. Robin Kumar, Superintendent of Police, Golaghat has stated that the police is taking extreme caution in effecting arrest of accused and is taking note of the guidelines of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India passed in Arnesh Kumar vs. State of Bihar, (2014) 8 SCC 273.

In the last meeting of the UTRC dated 15.5.2021 this Authority has already made some recommendation for release of UTPs which the High Powered Committee has approved in its meeting dated 16.5.2021 and till 21.5.2021 total 28 numbers of UTPs have been released from District Jail, Golaghat.

Hon'ble Chairman has thereupon raised the issue of vaccination of officers, staff, PLVs, Lawyers and Jail inmates. There are 292 Nos. of jail inmates within the age category of 18-44 and 65 nos. are of 45 and above age category, who have to be vaccinated. According to the Superintendent of District Jail, Golaghat, 26 numbers of inmates have tested covid positive out of 395 RAT conducted on 16.5.2021, and accordingly these covid-positive prisoners are shifted to Covid Care ward located inside the jail. It has also been informed by the Jail Superintendent that oxygen level, temperature and BP of Covid Positive prisoners are monitored regularly by one M&HO of the Jail. Further, the report submitted by the Superintendent, District Jail, Golaghat shows that upon contacted with the Joint Director of Health Services, Golaghat for vaccination of the Jail inmates, as of now only 57 Nos. of inmates found to be eligible for vaccination due to document and online registration issue.

Dr.Taufiq Hussain, Addl. Joint Director Health Services has informed the members that vaccine can be provided to those who has valid mobile phone number and valid documents, and as such technical issues have come up for online enrolment of inmates for vaccination . Further as


regards vaccination of judicial officers, advocates, para-legal volunteers, court staff and family members of the police personnel are concerned, this issue is facing the same problem as everyone have to take appointment online.

RESOLUTION


1. After deliberation on different aspects including technical aspects it has resolved that Dr.Taufiq Hussain, Addl. JDHS, Golaghat to discuss the matter with the District Immunization Officer, Golaghat and to come up with a solution to provide vaccination to all the jail inmates irrespective of their possessing document or mobile phone numbers as because many of the convicts have no phone numbers or valid documents.
2. District Immunization Officer, Golaghat is requested to explore option within the legal framework for conducting vaccination drive amongst lawyers, judicial officers, para-legal volunteers, court staffs, police personnel and their family members.
3. Secretary, DLSA, Golaghat has been asked to make coordination with the District Administration, Police Authorities, and Jail officials if need arises for providing of transport to the prisoners from the prisons up to their homes.
4. It has resolved that the next UTRC meeting to be held on 31.5.2021 and as such Secretary, DLSA, Golaghat is urged to take necessary steps.

With this discussion this meeting ends with a vote of thanks from the Chair.






