

**MINUTE OF MEETING OF THE UNDER TRIAL REVIEW COMMITTEE, GOLAGHAT, ASSAM HELD ON

A meeting of the Under Trial Review Committee has been held today on 4.4.2020 through whatsapp message, in pursuance to the direction dated 23.3.2020 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Suo Motu Writ Petition (C) No. 1/2020 under the Chairmanship of Sri S.K. Sharma, District & Sessions Judge-cum-Chairman, District Legal Services Authority, Golaghat, Assam and attended by following members:

**DISCUSSION & RESOLUTION**

From the List submitted by the Superintendent, District Jail, Golaghat it has found that except one inmate all the UTPs recommended for release in the meeting dated 27.3.2020 has been released. UTP Ranjit Barman of Bokakhat Court could not be released as he hails from West Bengal and it would be difficult to arrange for a vehicle for his transportation at this lockdown period.

From the data submitted by the Superintendent, District Jail, Golaghat the following resolution has been passed.







1. There exists no UTP who fulfils the criterion under section 436 and 436-A Cr.P.C for their release.
2. There is no UTP who is found to be released on bail by the Court but have not been able to furnish surety.
3. Following UTP has been found to have been incarcerated in compoundable offence of Cr.P.C.  
(a) Gangu Tanti alias Kartik in connection with PRC No.127/2019 u/s 341/323.

The committee has resolved to recommend this case for release of accused on P.R. Bond/ Bail-bond considering the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court to decongest jail for the outbreak Covid-19 disease.

4. No UTP is found to become eligible to be released u/s 167(2) (a)(i) & (ii) of the Cr.P.C and u/s 36A of the NDPS Act 1985.

- 5.No UTP is found to have been detained under Chapter-VIII of the Cr.P.C.
- 6.No UTP has been found fit to be released on probation under the Probation of Offenders Act, 1968.
- 7.No UTP within the age group of 19 and 21 years is found in custody for the offence punishable with less than 7 years of imprisonment and have suffered at least  $\frac{1}{4}$  th of the maximum sentence possible.
- 9.No UTP of unsound mind is found who can be dealt with under Ch-XXV of the Cr.P.C.
- 10.No UTP has been found to be eligible u/s 437(6) of the Cr.P.C.

The meeting is ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
